









Your cottage garden planting plan

In this planting plan, you will find a classic cottage garden with a layout modelled on the Hamburg cottage garden. There is a herb spiral in the crossroads, which harbours delicious culinary herbs. A wide variety of berries and flowers can be found along the path. The four beds can be easily cultivated with a four-crop rotation, which is a good start to growing mixed crops, especially for beginners. The beds are therefore planted with light, moderate and heavy feeders as well as green manure. The selected vegetable plants are particularly easy to care for and produce a high yield. So if you don't have much experience yet, this plan is a good place to start. A cottage garden is characterised by particularly high biodiversity. This allows you to actively combat species extinction and create a habitat.
